

Directions to John Jay Homestead - 684 to exit 6, Katonah. East on Route 35 1/4 mile to Rte 22 South. Follow Rte. 22 for 2 miles to John Jay Homestead State Historic Site on left. Police/volunteers will direct you where to park. Two-horse trailers use main driveway. Larger vans use secondary (dirt) driveway - Farm Rd. Please obey instructions - parking is tight.

- 1) Registration is limited to the first 130 teams. You must complete this form and mail it in with the names of all team members and a check for the **full amount. You may also pay via PayPal, www.bedfordridinglanes.com.** Please bring your PayPal receipt and Coggins to receive your entry packet. No pace reservations can be made without full payment. A valid Coggins form (less than one year old on 5/28/18) must be enclosed.
- 2) Go-arounds at all fences. Safety Helmets are required.
- 3) Please fill in your division. If you do not indicate the division in which you wish to compete, you will be assigned to Pleasure. There will be no changing divisions on the day of the pace.
 - Hunt** - Fast Pace
 - Pleasure** - moderate pace
 - Western** - there must be at least one Western rider per team.
 - Junior** - there must be at least one Junior rider (18 or under) per team.
- 4) Teams will consist of 2, 3, or 4 riders. All team members must complete the course.
- 5) There will be posted areas where riders must walk. Riders not obeying these signs will be eliminated.
- 6) Overtaking teams **MUST** ask permission to pass slower teams. Riders not observing this courtesy will be eliminated.
- 7) The Pace will be held rain or shine. There will be no refunds unless the Pace is cancelled by the Committee.
